- Broken hip, pelvis, or leg within the last month
- Stroke within the last month
- Serious trauma within the last month
- Spinal cord injury (paralysis) within last month

- Age 75 or over
- History of blood clots (DVT or Pulmonary Embolism)
- Family history of blood clots and related disorders

- Age 60-74 years
- Recent arthroscopic knee surgery
- Cancer (current or previous)
- Recent major surgery (>45 minutes)
- Recent laparoscopic surgery (>45 minutes)
- Recent bed rest (>72 hours)
- Plaster cast that has kept you from moving your limb in the last month
- Tube in blood vessel in neck or chest

Add 1 Point for each true statement

- Age 41-59 years
- Planned minor surgery in near future
- Major surgery within last month
- Varicose veins
- History of Inflammatory Bowel Disease
- Legs are currently swollen
- Overweight or obese

- Serious infection within last month
- Lung disease within last month
- Currently on bed rest or restricted mobility
